



## **Parents and Carers Parking**

Whilst we appreciate that the school is placed at the edge of the village's residential areas and that main access is on a very busy road; we must remind parents, that need to park near the school, that they must do so with consideration of local residents and visitors/staff that may be entering/leaving the school entrance at any time.

Parking on footpaths is both illegal and dangerous; similarly you must not park within the bus bay on the school side. We respectfully request that you do not obstruct or park across resident's drives, on both Hague Lane and Circular Drive, even for a short amount of time and also that you do not block the school gate entrance on Circular Drive at any time, as this is an emergency exit for pedestrians and also an alternative entrance for emergency vehicles should the need arise.

Whilst the zig zag lines on Hague Lane are not currently enforceable, they are there for a purpose. Parking on these lines and up to the school gates put both pedestrians and people leaving the school in vehicles at risk. We have had several near misses due to vehicles being parked irresponsibly in this area. We have been advised by Derbyshire police that if we have vehicles parking within the zig zag lines causing access and/or visual obstructions we can ask for them to be removed by the police as they are a danger to other road users.

Please help us to keep the roads and footpaths around the site safe for everyone who needs to use them; double up with another parent or take turns transporting children to/from school if you can or walk to school or use public transport if applicable and if you need to bring the car, please ensure you leave enough time to park further away from the site and walk to ensure a safer journey.
